The Problem

- Current estimates are over 3 Million orphans in Kenya & 42% of the population under the age of 14
- Over 25% of the population live on less than \$1 per day and
- 1 in 7 households in Kenya are headed by an orphan sibling
- 700 children are orphaned every day
- Children are displaced because of war, abandonment, disease and other reasons

SHIM Ministries

Up until February 2012, 40+ children were sleeping on a mud and cow manure floor of SHIM Church, a rural community church in Kiminini, Kenya. Since then, CEO has helped to provide food, clothes, school supplies and beds to sleep on for these children. You can help too!! A donation truly saves a life!

The Plan

- Raise the money by Christmas 2020
- Looking to buy 5 to 10 acres of land
- Land cost can fluctuate between \$2000-\$10,000/acre
- We have a phased approach to building the facilities
- The facility will be cinder block buildings with cement floors.
- We are looking in the outlying areas between Eldoret and Kiminini, Kenya
- The vision is a facility large enough for 100 children
